Screen Policy Matrix - Manitoba Baton Twirling Sportive Association - 2024

Level 1 - Low Risk

Description

Participants involved in low risk assignments who are not in a supervisory role, not directing others, not involved with finances, and/or do not have unsupervised access to Vulnerable Participants

Level 2- Medium Risk

Description

Participants involved in medium risk assignments who may be in a supervisory role, may direct others, may be 2. Assistant Coaches 18 & over under involved with finances, and/or who may have limited access to Vulnerable Participants,

Level 3 - High Risk Description

Participants involved in high risk assignments who occupy positions of trust and/or authority, have a supervisory role, direct others, and who have frequent or unsupervised access to Vulnerable Participants.

Baton related volunteers

- 1. Volunteers (parents/youth) helping on a non regular or informal basis - at competitions, performances, etc
- 2. Volunteers not involved with finances

Baton related volunteers

- 1. Board Members
- supervision of another coach*
- 3. Clinicians (Manitoba)**
- 4. Volunteers at outreach events

Baton related volunteers

- 1. Coaches in a position of trust, authority or a supervisory role (eg. Head coaches, private lessons, outreach events, coaches traveling with vulnerable participants)
- 2. Chaperones or Team Managers at out of town competitions or clinics if they are in a position of trust.

Screening requirement

- 1. Complete an Application Form (Appendix A)
- 2. Complete a Screening Disclosure Form (Appendix B)
- 3. Participate in training, orientation Policies, Respect in Sport, NCCP as determined by the organization

Screening requirement

- 1. Complete an Application Form (Appendix A)
- 2. Complete and provide an **E-PIC** (Enhanced Police Information Check)*
- 3. Participate in training, orientation Policies, Respect in Sport, NCCP as determined by the organization
- 4. Provide a driver's abstract if requested.

Screening requirement

- 1. Complete an Application Form (Appendix A)
- 2. Complete and provide an **E-PIC** (Enhanced Police Information Check) and a VSC (Vulnerable Sector Check)
- 3. Participate in training, orientation Policies, Respect in Sport, NCCP as determined by the organization
- 4. Provide a driver's abstract if requested.

*Young People

The Organization defines a young person as someone who is younger than 18 years old. When screening young people, the Organization will:

- 1. Not require the young person to obtain a VSC or E-PIC; and
- 2. In lieu of obtaining a VSC or E-PIC, require the young person to submit up to two (2) letters of reference.

Notwithstanding the above, the Organization may ask a young person to obtain a VSC or E-PIC if the Organization suspects the young person has an adult conviction and therefore has a criminal record. In these circumstances, the Organization will be clear in its request that it is not asking for the young person's youth record. The Organization understands that it may not request to see a young person's youth record.

** We can only require screening for Manitoba Members at this time.

Once CBTF develops a National Safe Sport Policy, screening for Out of Province Clinicians, Judges and other members will be reviewed in this policy.
