MANITOBA CONTINGENT ATHLETE CONTRACT & CODE OF CONDUCT

As a member of the MBTSA Provincial Contingent traveling to ______, you are hereby required to adhere to the contingent rules as outlined below.

Any violation of contingent rules will be brought to the attention of the MBTSA Contingent Manager, MBTSA Chairperson, and the athlete's coach, at which time the appropriate course of action will be determined. A serious breach will result in the termination of the offender's participation in the competition.

MANITOBA CONTINGENT RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. All members will be expected to behave in an acceptable manner, keeping in mind that they are representing both MBTSA and the Province of Manitoba.
- 2. Absolutely no alcohol, smoking or use of banned substances will be tolerated throughout the competition. (*Those in leadership positions are also encouraged to refrain from the use of such substances.)
- 3. All participants are required to remain in the facility unless prior notification has been made to the Contingent Manager, Coach, Parent, or Chaperon. Remaining at the competition facility will ensure that all competing athletes will have the full support of the rest of the Manitoba Contingent.
- 4. Curfew Athletes must be in their rooms by 9:00 PM until all competition has been completed.
- 5. Athletes will not be permitted in the swimming pool or hot tub until the competition is complete.
- 6. Unless they are part of the Manitoba Contingent, members of the opposite sex are strictly forbidden from being admitted to athletes' rooms.
- 7. When requested, all Manitoba Contingent members must wear the Manitoba Tracksuit in its optimum condition. Sleeves and pant hems are not to be rolled up.
- 8. There will be a Manitoba Contingent Itinerary to which members are expected to adhere to. If Manitoba Contingent Meetings are planned, all members are required to attend.
